

Schultz Park Neighborhood Meeting
February 1, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. Board members attending the neighborhood meeting were: Commissioners Gaffney, Kelly, Leck. Staff attending the meeting – Wilson. Carol Ann Surufka announced that \$10,895 has been raised to date by the group's fundraising efforts. Discussion was held on the different events and businesses that contributed to the fundraising. The community grant application that was submitted to Wal-Mart in 2009 will be resubmitted.

The Planning Committee provided an update on their work. Phase One will consist of purchasing and installing the swing sets, 3 tot, 2 ADA, and 5 regular swing seats. Phase 2 will be the purchase and installation of a play unit for children under 4 years of age. They would also like to work on the tennis, basketball and volleyball courts in the summer of 2010. Phase 3 will be the purchase and installation of a play unit for 5 years and older.

Kelly asked about lead time of the play equipment that was slated to be ordered. No information was available regarding to lead time. Kelly invited the neighborhood planning committee to the Park District's Planning Committee on February 3, 6:30pm to further discuss the phase one of the project and ordering the equipment.

Discussion was held on the Art in the Parks Project. Surufka explained the project and the group liked the idea of painting a table for the park. Particulars were briefly discussed, the fee was waived by the park district and a committee will be formed.

Future fundraisers were discussed for the group. A discussion was held about the condition of the grass and dandelions in the parks. Wilson provided an explanation relating to the dandelions and grass.

The next meeting of the Schultz Park Neighborhood Group will be Monday, March 8, 2010, 7:00pm at the Eisenhower Center.
