

Camp Wewannago Camper Checklist

Please send your campers with the following items to camp every day. Please label all items with your child's name.

Sunscreen and Hat

The campers will be outside most of the summer. Even on days where they are scheduled to be inside at the Eisenhower Center, camp activities may include some outdoor time (weather permitting). Campers will have opportunities to apply/reapply sunscreen by themselves throughout the day.

Lunch

Refrigeration is available for camper's lunches while they are at camp. On field trip days, lunches will not be able to be kept cool. Vending machine visits will not be available during camp so please send your camper with lunches including drinks and snacks. Due to various allergies, campers will not be allowed to share food with each other.

Water Bottle

Campers will have opportunities to refill water bottles throughout the day. It is important to send campers with a water bottle as they will be outdoors and active.

• Gym shoes and socks – Please No Sandals

Camp activities will include games and walking so it is important that campers wear gym shoes to prevent injuries. Sandals/crocs will only be allowed during pool time.

Comfortable Clothing

Day camp can get a bit messy between the games, outdoor playing, and arts and crafts activities. Please encourage your camper to wear clothing they don't mind getting messy.

Backpack

Please ensure that your child's backpack does not contain any unnecessary items as the children will be carrying their backpacks throughout the day.

Swim Suit, Towel, and Flip-Flops

Swimming will be every Thursday at the Eisenhower Center pool, weather permitting. There may be scheduled water days throughout camp and your child will bring home reminders for those days. Please be sure that your camper's towel is labeled with their name. If your child is not sure about the water, please be sure to indicate their ability levels on the water safety form. The day camp staff will be in the water with the campers.
