Recreation/Fitness/Aquatic Supervisor

Starting Salary \$44,720

This position is perfect for a recent college graduate. The Recreation/Fitness/Aquatics Supervisor will plan, promote, organize, and administer community-wide programs and summer camps for all ages, as well as oversee the operation of the district fitness center and swim program. Instruction of swim classes and some recreation programs will be included in this position that allows the candidate to gain experience in 1) a variety of interest areas, 2) supervising a staff of instructors and contractors, and 3) creating programs from idea to implementation. This is a full-time position (with occasional work for evening and weekend special events) that will get you to work immediately.

Qualifications: Bachelor's or Associate's Degree; Experience (either work or internship) in aquatics/fitness/athletics preferred; Lifeguard/swim experience; A current and valid driver's license

Salary: The starting salary is \$44,720 (\$21.50 per hour) to start plus an excellent benefits package

Position Requirements: The candidate will be required to pass a certified personal trainer program (cost of program paid) within 6 months of hiring, successfully teach swim classes in the indoor pool (training, if necessary, provided), teach some recreation programs (all ages) including athletic programs, maintain the cleanliness of the district fitness center and fitness equipment, handle district vending, teach some fitness classes, train and work some hours at the front desk, train and sub in the district preschool, when necessary.

Environment: Lan-Oak Park District serves the community of Lansing, IL, with a population of 28,000. The park district offers 18 parks, a 3.25-mile bike path, a skate park/BMX pump track, multiple athletic fields and courts, and a 60,000 square foot community center with a two-court gymnasium, gymnastics gym, full-service fitness center, 25-yard indoor pool, educational preschool, and multiple program rooms. Administrative and supervisor offices are housed in the community center.
